Staffing Update

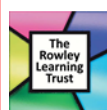

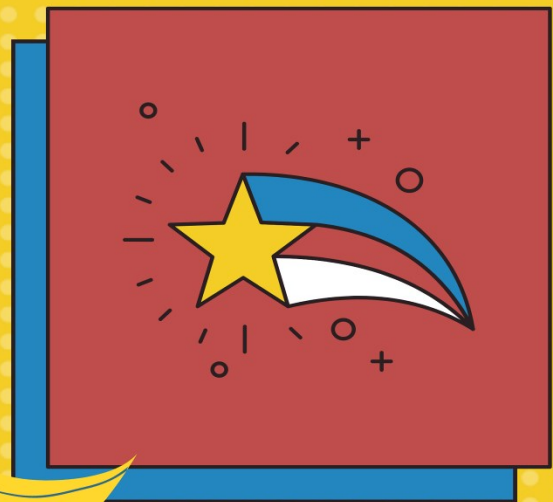
