Dear Parents/Carers

As you can see below, we had a really successful and busy meeting with our Pupil Parliament. One of our MP's gives a really clear account of the meeting below. During the meeting, I shared some of the Well Being Charter Mark development points linked to pupil voice with our MP's and we discussed together how we will address these over the coming term.

Please do read on further into the Newsletter to see an example of some writing from one of our Star of the Week pupils (Zayn) and some Maths (Sam). I'm sure you will agree the quality of work and the excellent presentation are to be very much admired.

We are excited to be launching a brand-new curriculum area at Temple Meadow called **Performing Arts**. Initially this will be rolled out in a phased approach starting with **Year 5**. When we introduce something new, we do like to adopt a phased approach so that we can 'tweak' and adapt prior to rolling out in other year groups. Performance is something that completes the learning diet we deliver at Temple Meadow. It is very much part of our vision for education and supports our values.

Miss Nugent leads on Performance at Temple Meadow. She is a specialist in this area and has a wealth of knowledge and experiences to support this exciting new venture. She is very keen and eager to get started!

As with all our curriculum areas we have put a lot of thought into curriculum design. Our Performance curriculum will cover the following strands:

**Dance:** creating choreography, learning choreography of different genres, history of dance and different genres, evaluating dance, performance of dance.

**Drama techniques:** acting, script reading, script writing, character exploration, reading with expression and intonation, confidence building, self-esteem and team work.

**Speaking and Listening:** performance poetry, evaluation of performance, podcasts, recording work for audiences, talking to an audience and reading aloud.

**Technology:** filming dance and drama outcomes, editing for screen use, lighting sequences, using technology for music, green screen, evaluations, career focus (producers, directors, editors), podcast and website outcomes and microphone use.

**Production:** stage management, planning a production, costumes, lighting leadership, directorship, team work, evaluation, music and sound and stage hands.

Whenever we deliver a Performance curriculum in a year group; elements of these strands above are woven into the lessons we plan. Performance is a curriculum with some unique elements but it is also strongly linked to other curriculum areas such as: Music, PE (Dance), English (reading and writing and communication and language); Computing and Technology.

So after spring half term in Year 5 and in the first half term of the summer term, there will be 12 learning episodes (lessons). The teaching focus will be Hip-Hop dance linked to a key performance artist. We have planned in a showcase to pupils and a performance slot for Year 5 parents as the children will be eager to share the hard work they have been doing. The date for this is: Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2023 at 2.30pm (30 minutes).

In the summer term, Year 4 will have a Performance Curriculum linked to 'Stomp'; more details on this to follow. Other year groups will get more details as we move forward with this initiative.



A reminder that Parents/Carers attending STAR Assembly are asked to sign in at the Dance Studio steps located by the Clifton Street pedestrian entrance.






