Dear Parents/Carers,

This half term has gone so quickly. We've hosted a really big range of events and trips across school. This week, we had our Careers Day and I'd like to say a really big thank you to the Parents/Carers that supported us, along with Governors and other professions, in talking to classes across the school. Children hearing about a range of careers really helps them to think and dream about the roles they'd like to do in the future and it really makes sense, connecting classroom learning to future aspirations. ### Football Event

As part of their 'Space Day', children came dressed in space themed costumes. Lots of the children created their own costumes made of recycled materials. We were very proud of the effort that families had made with children creating jet packs, helmets and space rockets. As part of their 'Move it Monday', they held an astronaut training camp and built their own space rockets to fly to the moon. Nursery have also been 'Out of this World' exploring space in their Rocketship role play. They have created some fantastic writing around what they would take with them in a rocket to the moon.



### Year 5 Fashion Show

Last week, the Year 9 clothing committee from Ormiston Forge Academy visited Temple Meadow to work with our Year 5 pupils. Children were using donated clothing to create outfits for the fashion show, which was presented to our Year 4 pupils. Throughout the day, pupils were required to justify their choice of clothing. With the support of the Year 9 students, our year 5's made alterations to clothing to suit their style and made outfits ready for the catwalk. The children have been working on projects which encourage people to re-love clothing rather than clothing ending up in landfill.
