Artsmark

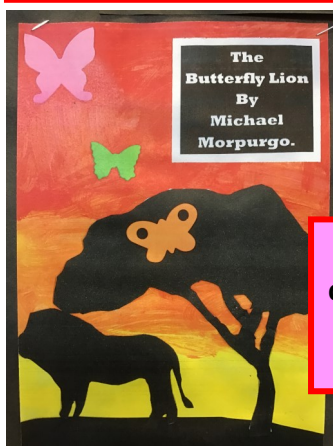

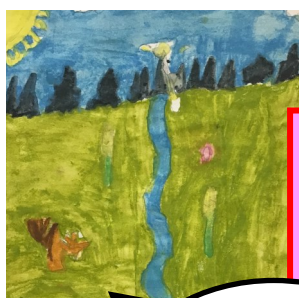
Year 1 made Tiger masks as part of their collage unit.
