### Maths Stay and Play (Nursery)

Dear Parents/Carers

*During the last week of term, we wrote to you to inform you of a **Nursery Maths Stay and Play**, taking place on **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024**. We are now providing you with updated information linked to this event; please do disregard the previous letter sent and digest the information stated below:*

Dear Parents/Carers

We would like to invite you to join us for a Stay and Play Session. This is an opportunity for you to see your child showcase different mathematical skills in their class. As a school, we implement Singapore Maths into our curriculum and it is important that Parents/Carers understand our approach and how you can best support your child. We would highly encourage your attendance; starting from an early age, Maths helps to develop children's understanding, including problem solving and reading.

In addition, we have also invited our local family hub leader who will share different family programmes and workshops you can access locally to support you and your family.

There will be two sessions for you to choose from:

**AM Nursery: Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January 9-10am**

**PM Nursery: Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2-3pm**

**Rabbits (30 hour children): You can choose either of the above sessions.**

We are limited as to how many adults we can have in a session so we are only able to invite one adult per child; younger siblings should not attend. Parents/Carers are asked to wait on the Nursery playground, entering as normal via Clifton Street, whilst the pupils go into Nursery to be registered.

Once pupils are registered, Parents/Carers will then enter the classroom and sign in with the Nursery adult on the door. Parents/Carers are permitted to take their child home following the Stay and Play event (older siblings are to remain in school) and will need to sign out their child at the School Office before leaving.

**Mobile phones should not be used in the Early Years setting and we politely request that no food and drink are brought with you as we have a number of children with nut allergies.**
