Wellcomm Stay and Play (Nursery)

Dear Parents/Carers

On **Friday 9th February 2024**; we would like to invite you to our WellComm Stay and Play workshop for Nursery Parents/Carers. During the workshop, there will be a Wellcomm presentation held by Harriet Clarke (Speech and Language Therapist). You will then spend time in class with your child for a Wellcomm focused Stay & Play to support your understanding of Wellcomm and to aid you in supporting your child with their speech and language skills.

There will be two sessions available:

AM Nursery: Friday 9th February 2024 9-10am

PM Nursery: Friday 9th February 2024 2-3pm

Rabbits (30 hour children): You can choose either of the above sessions.

We are limited as to how many adults we can have in a session so we are only able to invite one adult per child; younger siblings should not attend.

If attending during the AM session, please arrive at the Nursery gate as usual. Once pupils are registered, Parents/Carers will then enter the classroom and sign in with the Nursery adult on the door.

If attending during the PM session, please arrive at the Nursery gate at 2pm. Parents/Carers will then enter the classroom and sign in with the Nursery adult on the door.

Parents/Carers are permitted to take their child home following the Stay and Play event (older siblings are to remain in school) and will need to sign out their child at the School Office before leaving.

Mobile phones should not be used in the Early Years setting and we politely request that no food and drink are brought with you as we have a number of children with nut allergies.
