English

This term, we will be looking at the text The Closest Thing to Flying. In reading comprehension lessons, we will be exploring how narrative content is related and contributes to meaning as a whole; exploring how meaning is enhanced through choice of words and phrases; and making comparisons. In writing lessons, we will be planning, drafting and writing an information text, a narrative and an ode.

Maths

This half term, we will be continuing to focus on money, geometry, perimeter and length. In money, we will be using all 4 operations to solve problems. In geometry will be identifying, comparing and ordering angles, as well as identifying quadrilaterals and lines of symmetry. We will fine the perimeter of a rectangle and solve problems using kilometres

Science

This half term, we will be exploring living things and their habitats. We will be learning to recognise that animals can be grouped into vertebrates and invertebrates; group plants into categories such as flowering plants and non-flowering plants; and recognise that environments change over time and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

Art and Design

This half term, we will be focusing on sculpture. We will be learning to annotate sketches to explain and elaborate ideas; create and combine shapes to create recognisable forms; and include texture that conveys feelings, expression or movement.

Learning 4 Life

This half term, will be focusing on the unit Perfect Planet. In this unit, we will be learning how we can stop clothes going to landfill by exploring ways to recycle clothing.



Year 4 Summer 1



<u>R.E.</u>

This half term exploring what is it like to be a Hindu, including community, worship and celebration. We will be learning to make links between Hindu practices and the idea that Hinduism is a whole 'way of life' (dharma); identify some different ways in which Hindus show their faith; and describe how Hindus show their faith within their families in Britain today.

<u>P.E.</u>

This half term, we will be focusing on Performing Arts. In this unit, we will be researching the history of Stomp, then plan, rehearse and perform our own routines.

Music

This half term, 4 Cowell will be continuing to learn the P-bone. We will be learning how to look after and care for our P-bone as well as how to play different notes of varying pitch and tone.

4 Ahlberg will be exploring different instruments and covering any of the music curriculum missed due to Covid.

Computing

This half term, we will be recording and editing sound. We will also create a Pod cast. We will record the voice tracks for our podcast. We will then review our recordings and re-record if necessary. Learners will edit, trim, and align their voice recordings.

Geography

This half term, we will be exploring rivers. We will be learning about the main features of a river and the impact that they have on the environment around them.

The children will be conducting fieldwork at a river.
