Protective Behaviours and RSHE parent information session

At Temple Meadow, Learning 4 Life is our bespoke PSHE (personal, social and health education) curriculum which has been carefully designed to develop the knowledge, skills and attributes pupils need to keep themselves healthy and safe, and prepare them for future learning and employment. Our curriculum intention is to develop pupils' skills and attributes such as resilience, self-esteem, riskmanagement, team-working and critical thinking.

There are two key elements that underpin our Learning 4 Life curriculum – Protective Behaviours and the RSHE (relationships, sex and health education) statutory guidance. Both of these are integral to our school's effective safeguarding culture and in developing pupils' social, emotional and mental well-being. Furthermore, Protective Behaviours plays a key role in our school behaviour policy implementation.

We would like to offer you the opportunity to find out more about Protective Behaviours and RSHE at Temple Meadow, as well as offering you a flavour of our Learning 4 Life curriculum. On Thursday 19th October 2023, we will be offering a Parent/Carer information session where you can find out more about:

- RSHE statutory guidance and what this means for your child at Temple Meadow
- The two key themes of Protective Behaviours that we teach and the strategies that we use to support and empower children
- Our wider Learning 4 Life curriculum, which includes themes such as Fit 4 Life, Aiming High and Perfect Planet
- How you can explore and implement some of the key aspects at home with your child(ren).
