This trip will link to the Islam unit that your child is currently learning about in school. This unit is called "What can we learn from religion about temptation? (Christians and Muslims)."

Our aim is for all children to experience a wide range of temple/churches (supporting community cohesion and understanding) on their journey through school. - 9.30-9.45: children to leave and arrive at Cradley Heath Mosque
- 9.40-10.15: children to enter place of worship and get a guided tour
- 10.30-11.10: children to have a talk from a mosque member
- 11.10-11.20: children to revisit places and ask further questions
- 11.20- 11.35: children to walk back to school
- 11.35-11.50: children to have a late breaktime
